

## How to get there

### By plane

Barcelona International Airport, El Prat, is 28 km away from Sitges. Most airline companies operate in this airport. There are daily flights to various Spanish and European cities, as well as to other continents. The airlift guarantees continuous connections with Madrid. It is possible to arrive to the airport by train from Sitges. Every thirty minutes there are trains that connect Sitges with the Prat de Llobregat railway station, where a direct train to the airport can be taken. The same journey can also be done in both directions: from the airport to the Prat de Llobregat and from the Prat de Llobregat to Sitges.

Furthermore, the airport connects Sitges through C-32 or C-31 (C-246) motorways.



### By road

C-32 motorway connects Sitges with Barcelona in 30 minutes, and with Tarragona in 45 minutes. From Vilafranca del Penedès, AP-7 motorway connects with Sitges. Northwards, AP-7 arrives until La Jonquera border and connects with the network of European motorways and southwards, with the rest of the Spanish motorways.



### By train

Sitges has very good connections with Barcelona and Tarragona by means of RENFE suburban and regional trains. There is a train approximately every 15 minutes that connects Sitges with Barcelona in only 30 minutes. The new train service connects Sitges with Barcelona without shutdown. Daily trains leave from Barcelona Sants towards the rest of Spain and Europe.

It is planned to build a high speed train which will join Barcelona and Madrid in only 3 hours, and which will connect with the European road network.



### By sea

Sitges has three sport ports with access to boats of the following maximum dimensions:

Barcelona and Tarragona have important ports with regular lines to the Balears Islands and Genoa.
